3050 Comfort Fit Shampoo Bowl

****CARE AND CLEANING INSTRUCTIONS****

Comfort Fit® Shampoo Bowls are molded from solid surface resins and provide a highly durable surface. To maintain the glossy appearance and prevent stains, rinse away any chemicals or dyes immediately and dry the sink after use.

A. Care:

- a. Clean with warm soapy water, ammonia-based cleaners, or commercially available solid surface cleaners to remove dirt and residue. Using abrasive cleaners will scratch the surface and dull the glossy appearance.

B. Preventing stains from dyes and salon chemicals:

- a. Rinse and dry the sink after exposure to dyes.
- b. Protect the finish by periodically applying a liquid polish to the surfaces of the sink as a stain prevention barrier. Gel-Gloss® sink polish is recommended, or any quality automotive polish. Apply per the manufacturer's instructions.
- c. Drain cleaners containing caustic or alkaline chemicals may cause surface damage to the sink and should not be used.

C. Removing Stains:

- a. Rinse and wipe the product from the surface as soon as possible.
- b. We suggest you start with a non-abrasive bleach cleanser (Soft Scrub Gel®), apply to the affected areas and let it set for a few minutes, then wipe with a non-abrasive pad or cloth.
- c. Rinse and check the progress, multiple applications may be required.
- d. Alternately, there are several other cleaning products that are safe to apply to Comfort Fit bowls and may provide better results, depending on the makeup of the stain:
 - i. Ammonia
 - ii. Strong Detergents
 - iii. Oxalic Acid solutions
 - iv. Dilute hydrochloric acid solutions
 - v. Acetone
- e. Hard water stains can be removed with an acidic solution, we suggest Bar Keepers Friend® cleaner.
- f. When the stain is treated, re-apply a polish to the sink surfaces.

D. Restoring the finish:

- a. Small scratches or dullness can sometimes be buffed out using fine cut rubbing compound, this is best done with an orbital polishing tool.
